

Worth 4-H meetings change form, not value

Worth County 4-H members, leaders and supporters are continuing to adapt their activities while in-person gatherings aren't encouraged. That includes regular group meetings, with members and leaders joining Extension staff via video conference to check in on Worth County 4-H.

Since the start of the new school year, also the start of the new 4-H year, leaders and their Extension support system have been working to make sure that the youth involved have as many of the same opportunities as possible.

Part of that has involved virtual discussions with leaders and members invited to take part.

Take, for example, the latest meeting, which was held on November 15, with 4-H'ers, families and leaders taking part.

As the meeting opened, Worth County Extension Education Specialist Dennis Johnson offered to play host for clubs whose leaders aren't as experienced with video conferences, giving their members a chance to

continue the individual clubs' meetings, which can be a vital part of the 4-H experience.

Also offered was a chance for club leaders to take part in Extension-led virtual meeting training, which will be held December 7-9, with meetings held at 7 p.m. each night. Leaders would only need to take part in one evening.

After the offering of support for clubs to branch off in their own virtual gatherings, the county catch up meeting began, with an example given of a typical meeting format, for new 4-H members who may be taking part.

Cecelia Hill led the pledge of allegiance, the way regular 4-H meetings would begin.

Hill then gave an update on the State 4-H Council project to collect donations for local food drives. So far the local members of the council, including Hill, Tianna Charlson, Kelsie Kinne and Hannah Lanphere, have raised money, but are still looking for donations of food items, as well as monetary donations, at the local Extension office. The

Harvest wraps up a positive year for local farmers

Sometimes, as a harvest season winds down, there is a need to search for a bright side, or to acknowledge that no news is good news. But not so, this year, said Worth County Extension Education Specialist Dennis Johnson.

According to Johnson, "It's pretty much all positives this year."

Johnson said that the last time Worth County had seen such a positive result as the season came to a close was in 2010, when Worth had the second highest yield in Iowa.

Johnson said Worth was fortunate to avoid some of the weather pitfalls elsewhere in Iowa. "We were lucky. We didn't get the drought of western Iowa. And we didn't see any of the devastation of the derecho."

From the start of the year, it seemed, Mother Nature was on board. Planting started early, and well.

"It was one of the best starts to a season in recent years," said Johnson. "Most farmers had their crop in the ground by May."

Johnson said he thought a lot of the enthusiastic early start came following the wet springs of recent years, when the overabundance of moisture put too much in jeopardy.

"They just kept their planters going." With the onset of

summer, things just kept going as well, with nearly ideal conditions.

"We did OK in the summer months too. We had enough growing degree days. We had timely rains. It all came together well."

And the fall was more of the same, with no real worries standing in front of local farmers.

What moisture did fall, came with good timing and in the right amounts. Just enough to warrant an occasional break for the farmers, but not enough to hamper their efforts.

"By the end of September, beans were ready," Johnson said. "And by the end of October, corn was set too. There wasn't as much drying needed, so most of it went right in the bin."

If that wasn't enough to bring some relief to the farmers, then better than expected prices going into harvest time only sealed the deal.

Johnson said ethanol plants provided a good amount of demand as they started ramping up production.

The savings on fuel for drying and the demand to produce ethanol led to favorable trends, according to Johnson.

"All in all, you really couldn't ask for a much better year," Johnson said.

local goal is to bring in enough for 100 donated items. That would make 10,000 items if repeated statewide.

Next on the agenda was an example of a typical meeting agenda, with a demonstration of parliamentary procedure, led by Charlson. She explained a meeting's agenda and was assisted in demonstrations of motions and forming committees to look at various topics.

Worth County Extension Youth Coordinator Mindy Tenold led an example of a meeting icebreaker, as those in the conference took part in an impromptu scavenger hunt.

Tenold followed that with some information on options for record book work and assistance.

Johnson updated everyone on tentative plans for December calf weigh-ins, which are still being required for those that want to take part in the Iowa State Fair. Johnson said that they may not be necessary to enter the Worth County Fair this coming summer.

Johnson then shared that Worth County had been recognized as tops in the

region for fundraising for the Iowa 4-H Foundation.

For those new and re-enrolling 4-H members, in light of the differences due to COVID-19, Johnson said that the Extension council, and the county's clubs would likely be covering any costs this year.

Johnson then shared a slide show, which had been designed to be shown in the county's elementary schools during National 4-H Week. Unfortunately, that wasn't an option with schools limiting outside visitors and contacts.

Following that, Lanphere gave a presentation of her own, on how to give a presentation, to improve communication skills, confidence and public speaking abilities.

Lanphere then led the meeting to a close with the regular meeting closing tradition, the 4-H pledge:

"I pledge my head to clearer thinking,

"My heart to greater loyalty,

"My hands to larger service,

"and my health to better living,

"for my club, my community, my country, and my world."
